Eligibility

The scholarship program is available to <u>Nelson County Residents Only</u>. Eligibility for a scholarship is based upon gross annual income and household size (see eligibility chart below). Proper documentation must be submitted in order to be considered for eligibility (see income documentation). If the applicant does not have the required documentation then they must have income verified by the Nelson County, Department of Social Services using their standard income verification processes and methods.

Benefits

Recreational Classes, Programs and Camps

The Parks and Recreation scholarship provides a discounted fee for recreational classes, programs and camps on a sliding scale based on gross annual income and household size see Eligibility chart below).

Restrictions

The Parks & Recreation scholarship is not valid for the following programs or services:

• Adult League Sports

Application Procedure & Income Documentation

In order to be considered for a Parks & Recreation scholarship, a signed application with the following documentation must be submitted.

- Proof of residency (valid driver's license, utility bill, tax statement/bill or other proof of residency and
- A signed copy of all adult applicants current U.S. Individual Federal Income Tax return (see below) or
- A signed waiver on the application to obtain financial information from the Department of Social Services.

Tax Return Information

For applicants submitting their current U.S. Individual Tax Return (Form 1040A or 1040EZ), you must submit tax returns for all working adults listed on the application. The total number of people listed on the application will be used to determine the household size on the discount chart and the income documentation must match.

Special Instructions

- If the filing status on the tax return is checked "Married Filing Separately", the applicant must submit their spouses tax return.
- If the applicant can be claimed as a dependent on their tax return, the applicant must provide the tax return(s) of the person(s) claiming them as a dependent.
- Monies received from scholarships, student loans and/or investments count as income and will be used in determining your gross annual income.

Parks & Recreation does not require social security numbers, so please black out that information prior to submitting. All income documentation will be destroyed following approval.

Applications (with documentation) may be submitted in person at the Nelson Parks and Recreation office.

Application Review and Award

Upon receipt of a scholarship application, Parks & Recreation staff will review the application (5-10 business days) and will make a financial assistance determination based upon the information submitted. The application will not be processed until all necessary documents are provided. All applicants will be notified once a decision has been made.

Re-Verification

Once the scholarship has been awarded, the applicant is required to re-verify their incme and the household size every twelve (12) months in order to maintain their scholarship discount. The applicant may re-submit their financial information at any time if their income level changes and would like to be considered for a larger discount. If there any changes in the household size during the duration of the scholarship, new income documentation will be required.
